Severance, Colorado, located about 20 miles east of Fort Collins and about 15 miles north of Greeley, is the fastest growing community per capita in the state. A large number of housing developments being built all around the area have given a suburban look to what used to be a small rural community with a lot of ranching and farming comprising the make-up of the community. Although ranching and farming continue to be the primary industry in the area, the community has become a bedroom community to the expanding communities of Fort Collins and Greeley. It is a community, however, that for the last 60-70 years has not had a church.
